Q: Is there a cost involved in changing an existing society's constitution and/or bylaws? The Hope Crime Prevention Society will soon hold it's Annual General Meeting at which time the WHOLE executive, (president, vice president, treasurer, secretary and 3 board members) must be elected. I am interested in having some executives terms modified to a 2-year term and some to a 1-year term in order to have some continuity for the guidance of potential new board members. Thank you for your prompt response to this request for guidance.

A: The cost involved in changing a society's bylaws and constitution, which is voted on by the membership and normally occurs at an Annual General Meeting, is \$ 50.00 as long as both are changed at the same time. A Form 10 must also be completed.
