We are delighted to inform you that your EMAIL ADDRESS Account has won you 1,850,000.00 USD from the Canadian Lotto Lore program held in London UK and Ontario Canada.

You are to contact the claims director with the following:

A: This e-mail message is one of a variety of scams that have been around for several years. It is actually a Foreign Lottery Scam and, had you decided to respond to the e-mail and pursue your claim, you would be asked to pay some sort of administrative fee to collect your "winnings". Of course there is no such prize and you will lose money in the end along with your personal information.

Sometimes the authors of these scams will include a reference to a Web site (phony or legitimate) to add a degree of authenticity to the prize pitch and convince recipients that the prize is on a level with established Canadian lotteries such as 6/49, Super 7, etc.

Responding to this type of e-mail message may also result in your e-mail address being added to a 'suckers' list and you'll receive hundreds of spam messages. The best advice we can give is to just delete these messages without even opening them.
